STAGE I

Digital Qualifying

Professional judges assess each submitted video, selecting the best 5 per country and per gender.

STAGE III

The **2018 WDSF World Youth Breaking Championships** held in Japan determine the 9 qualified b-boys (1 per NOC) and the 9 qualified b-girls (1 per NOC); it also confirms the 2 Universality and ARG b-boys as well as the 2 Universality and ARG b-girls.
